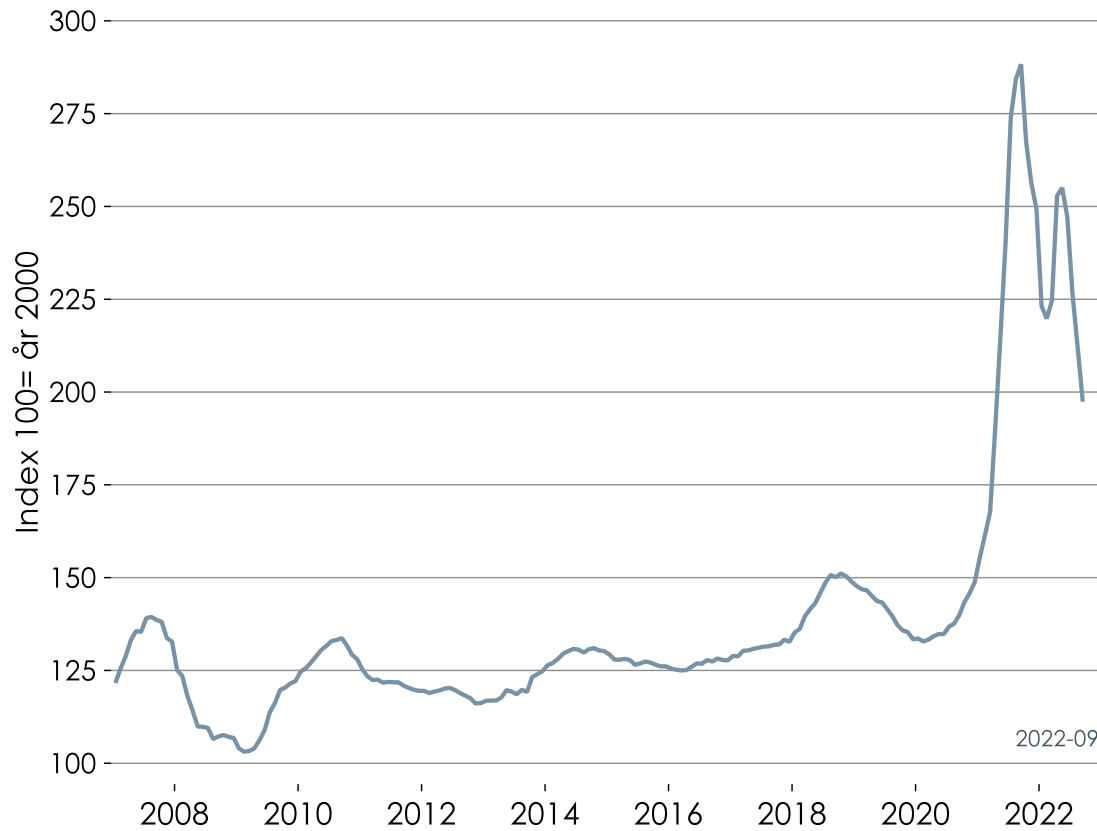

# Swedish Domestic Price Index, Softwood



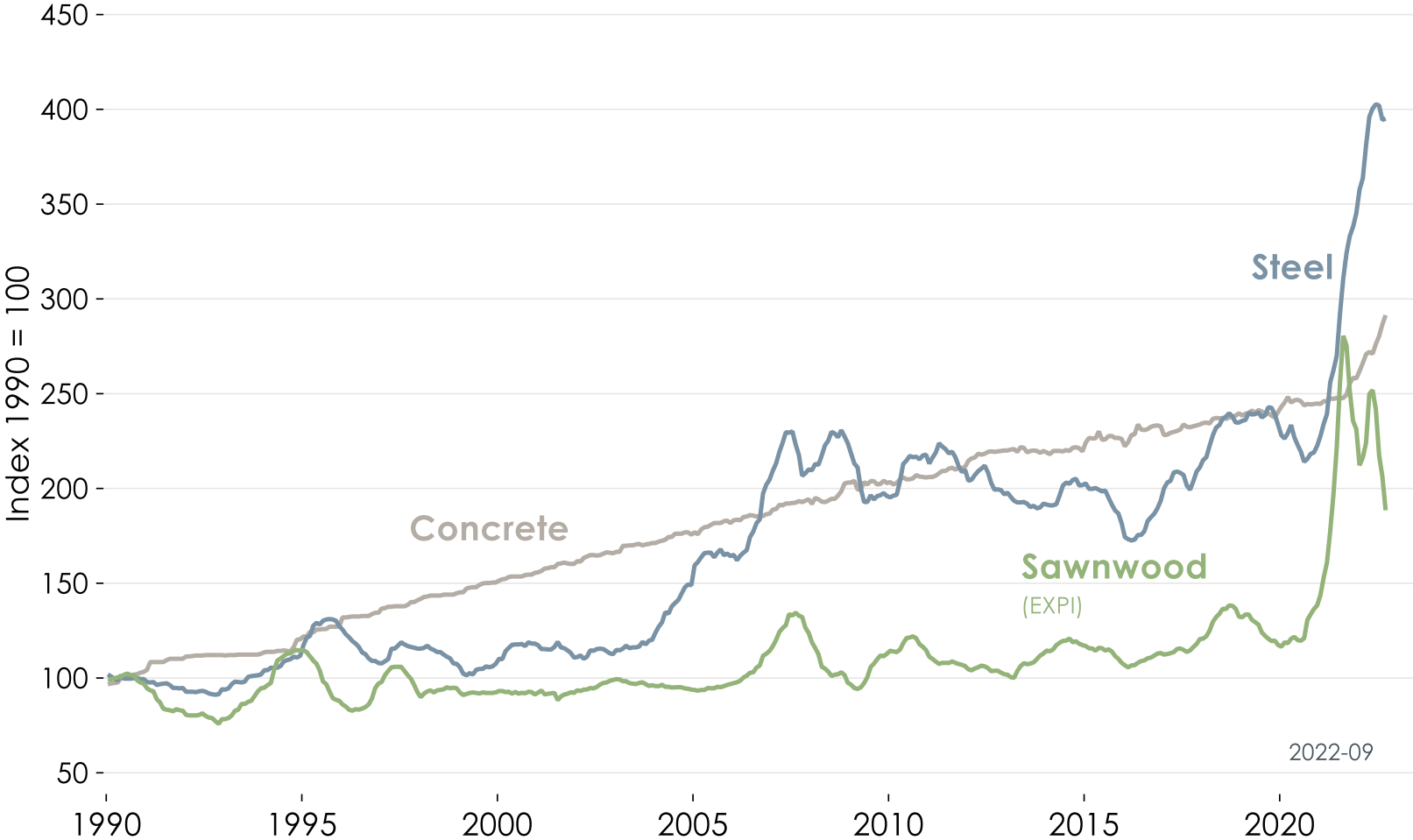
## Sawn and Planed Wood, Domestic Change compared with (%)

# Swedish Price Indexes for Softwood

Index numbers (2000=100) refer to monthly deliveries and are based on several dimensions/qualities (about 40 dimensions/qualities of sawn and planed redwood and whitewood).

The Indexes describe the development in SEK/m<sup>3</sup> and are therefore directly influenced by the currency fluctuations.

Please note that the index for the domestic market is based on the price development for *all* sawn and planed wood produced at Swedish sawmills (CN 4407). This means that also hardwood products are included. But as the share of hardwood produced in Swedish sawmills is very small the influence from hardwood products should be quite marginal.

Index series are compiled by SCB (Statistics Sweden).
